



# WOOD PELLET BAG RECYCLING BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 2014



## FREE FREE FREE

The Franklin County Solid Waste Management District has been awarded a Massachusetts Community Innovation Challenge Grant and a grant from MassDEP to implement a recycling program for wood pellet bags.

Step #1: WOOD PELLET BAGS ONLY! Other plastic bags are not acceptable. We cannot accept feed bags, soil bags, pesticide bags, or stretch film. These will put a halt to our recycling program.

Step #2: All bags must be dry. Wet bags will cause the entire load to be rejected by the recycling company.

Step #3: Shake out all wood pellets before recycling. You can cut the bottom off the bag to release pellets. Wood pellets and plastic bag recycling don't mix. Empty your bags!
